Sentencing Update for June Trials

On June 9th, a Douglas County jury returned a verdict convicting twenty-nine-year-old Stanley Granger of aggravated assault, battery, and driving under the influence. Granger was sentenced on June 28th. Chief Superior Court Judge William "Beau" McClain having heard all the evidence sentenced Granger to serve twenty-one years in prison.

On June 17th, a Douglas County jury returned a verdict convicting thirty-nine-year-old Abraham Hardy of eight charges of child molestation, four charges of enticing a child for indecent purposes, three charges of aggravated child molestation, and one charge of statutory rape. Hardy was sentenced on June 28th. Chief Superior Court Judge William "Beau" McClain having heard all the evidence sentenced Hardy to serve three life sentences in prison to be served consecutively.

Douglas County District Attorney Dalia Racine stated, "We are proud of the efforts of our team and law enforcement partners to obtain justice for those victimized in our community. We are grateful to the jurors for listening to the evidence in these cases and setting a standard to hold offenders accountable in our community."
